



Allgood Auto Supply

This building was constructed in 1946 as a result of the post-World War II boom. Engineered in the international-style common after soldiers returned home, this building was originally Allgood's Auto Supply Store. Mr. Larry L. Allgood, Jr., better known as "Bull", began his business December 9, 1951 and remained in business for over 50 years. Upstairs housed a CPA, dentist, and grocery store. This building was notable in Toccoa history for serving as a fallout shelter during the Cold War, as three-fourths of the basement was underground.
