Guidelines for participation:

- **Eligibility:** Open to businesses, civic groups, churches, schools, individuals, families, and non-profit organizations.
- **Purpose:** Each decorated Christmas tree supports a designated non-profit organization in Stephens County.
- **Tree Requirements:**
 - Only artificial trees are permitted (4–9 feet tall).
 - Participants are responsible for providing and decorating their tree.
 - Be creative! Choose a unique theme and name for your tree.
 - Trees and decorations remain the property of the participant.
- **Setup and Decorating:**
 - Complete tree decorating between December 1–3, during office hours (8 AM–5 PM).
 - Electric outlets are provided; bring your own extension cords.
- **Viewing and Voting:**
 - Public viewing: December 4–10, during posted hours.
 - Voting: Friday, December 5, during ChristmasFest (5 PM–9 PM).
 - Voting tickets: \$1 each.
- **Cleanup:**
 - Deadline for tree and decoration pickup: Friday, December 12.
- **Entry Deadline:** Submit entries by November 28.
- **Winner Announcement:** Winners will be announced on WNEG.
- **Liability:** Main Street Toccoa is not responsible for lost or stolen decorations during the exhibit.
